Gospel, Message: In the NT, *gospel* is never used for a written document, but is the comprehensive term for the good news of God's saving act in Jesus Christ, communicated in a variety of images and concepts.

Gospels: The word *gospel* is based on the Old English term *god spel*, "good news" or "good tidings." In turn a translation of the ecclesiastical Latin terms *bona annuntiatio* and *evangelium* ("good news"), one a translation and the other a transliteration of the Greek term **euangelion** ("good news").

I invite you to join me in reading the four Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, during 2022. One chapter a day starting with Matthew 1 on January 1. We will read each Book four times over the course of the year. One chapter a day reading slowly and plowing deeply into the text. Doing so we will allow God to plant seeds deeply. Those seeds will germinate, sprout and grow as we return again and again and again to the texts repeatedly during the year. The reading plan is included in this month's newsletter and copies will be in the Narthex and church office.

Please join me on Kresge's Facebook page as I'll publish a devotional thought each morning from the chapter we read. I look forward to your thoughts and comments as we learn and grow together. As quickly as I can after back surgery, we will meet during the week to discuss what we've read and answer questions we may have.

2022 is the Year of Gospel – The Good News of Jesus Christ – may we all be blessed and share the Good News of Jesus Christ with many!
